Dear Friends! Greetings to all!

We are happy to inform you that the Cosmopolitan Hospital and the Radiologic physics Foundation (RPF) are jointly organizing a one-day workshop on Radiation safety in International cardiology, for the first time in India. It is being organized at the Cosmopolitan Hospital, Thiruvananthapuram.

All of you are aware that Fluoroscopy is a real time imaging which employs a cath lab, C-Arm X-ray machines for medical application. It is known that Fluoroscopy is the highest contributor of radiation dose to both patients and occupational workers. It contributes about 30% of the total radiation dose though it is employed in 3% of patients. During the procedure all staffs; Cardiologists, Technicians, Nurses, and others are near the patients while X-ray beam on ON and the procedure may take from few minutes to hours. There is a chance that they may be exposed to higher level of radiation, that could exceed the occupational limits. Hence, it is decided to conduct a one-day workshop on interventional cardiology to emphasize radiation safety and standard operating procedures (SOP). Experts in the field will deliver lectures, including scientists, Physicists, in and around Kerala states.

The course is meant for radiation professionals of hospitals and health care institutions.

Cardiologists, Radiologists, Post graduates of MD/DM course, Cathlab technicians, Nurses,
Radiographers, Biomedical engineers, Medical physicist, and Graduates/Diplomas of Cardiac /Cath
Lab Technology/ Radiography Technology course of Allied health sciences (AHS), Radiation
Physics students can participate in the workshop.

This workshop shall create awareness on Radiological safety, especially in interventional cardiology procedures. It will provide immediate transfer of knowledge that can be used in clinical practice so that participants can carry out interventional radiation procedures with more confidence with minimal radiation exposure.

Only Sixty (60) participants will be enrolled as a first come-first serve basis. All participants are given certificates after the completion of the workshop which will be useful for NABH and NMC inspections and getting accreditation of hospitals or empanel of hospitals for treatment and insurance.
